



Volunteer Frequently Asked Questions

If you are considering volunteering at Moravian Manor Communities, we recommend taking a few minutes to review the following frequently asked questions. If you have additional questions that are not answered below, please contact us and we'll be happy to assist you with further information.

Who can volunteer at Moravian Manor Communities?

We request that individuals be at least 14 years of age, unless they are under the supervision of a parent, group leader, or Moravian Manor Communities staff member. And of course, you are never too old to volunteer, nor do we expect you to put in long hours.

How do I become a volunteer?

If you want to donate your time and talent as a volunteer at Moravian Manor Communities, complete a volunteer application and agreement, in-person interview with the Volunteer Services Director, background check (paid by us), and volunteer orientation and other training programs as applicable. A HIPAA statement must also be signed prior to service. If you are under 18 years old, we will also need a parent/guardian signature on your volunteer application/agreement.

Is there a minimum commitment of hours?

No, there is no minimum number of hours or days that you are required to volunteer. You may volunteer for as little or as much as you prefer during the day, evenings and/or weekends based on the community's need and your availability.

Where in the community can I volunteer?

Volunteers are assigned responsibilities for which they qualify, by virtue of their interests, talents, skills and availability. Typical volunteer roles include transporting residents to activities or on-campus services such as to the salon; visiting one-on-one; assisting with crafts or in the office; or distributing the mail. If you have a particular interest and we have a need, you can request to volunteer in other ways too.

Do you allow groups to volunteer?

Yes, we permit groups such as youth groups, scouting troops, high school service clubs, church, or civic groups to volunteer at Moravian Manor Communities. We recommend that you contact our Volunteer Services Director to discuss availability opportunities and timing.

Can you issue service hour credits?

Yes, if you are volunteering to gain service hour credits for a school or scouting project, religious programs (such as Confirmation), National Honor Society, or similar, we can complete the required documentation once the requirement is met. Note, we do not offer community service for a judicial issue.
