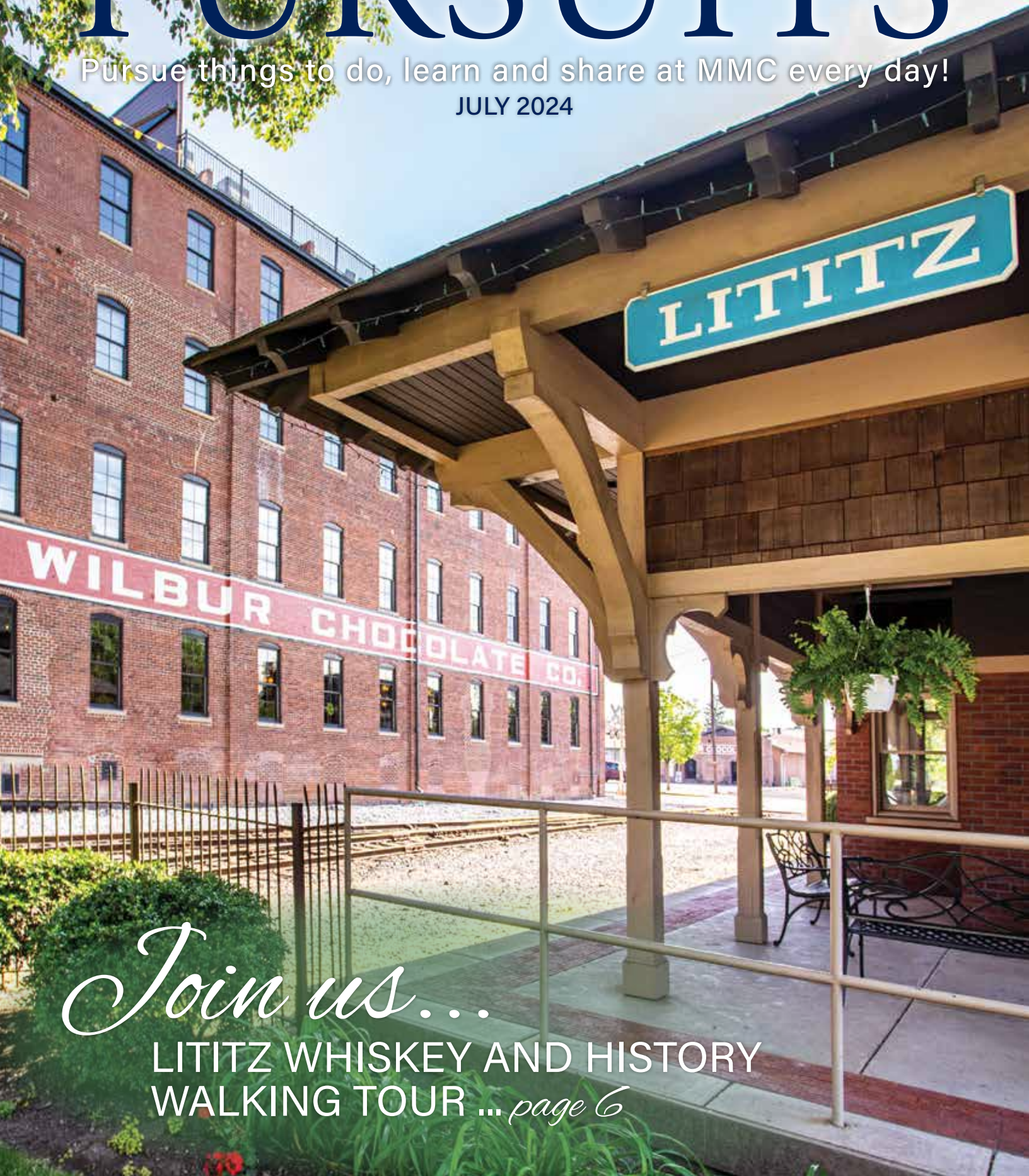

## Hiking Club Hike Union Canal Trail with Picnic Lunch
