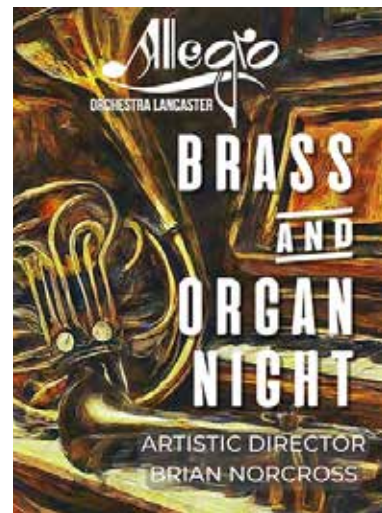

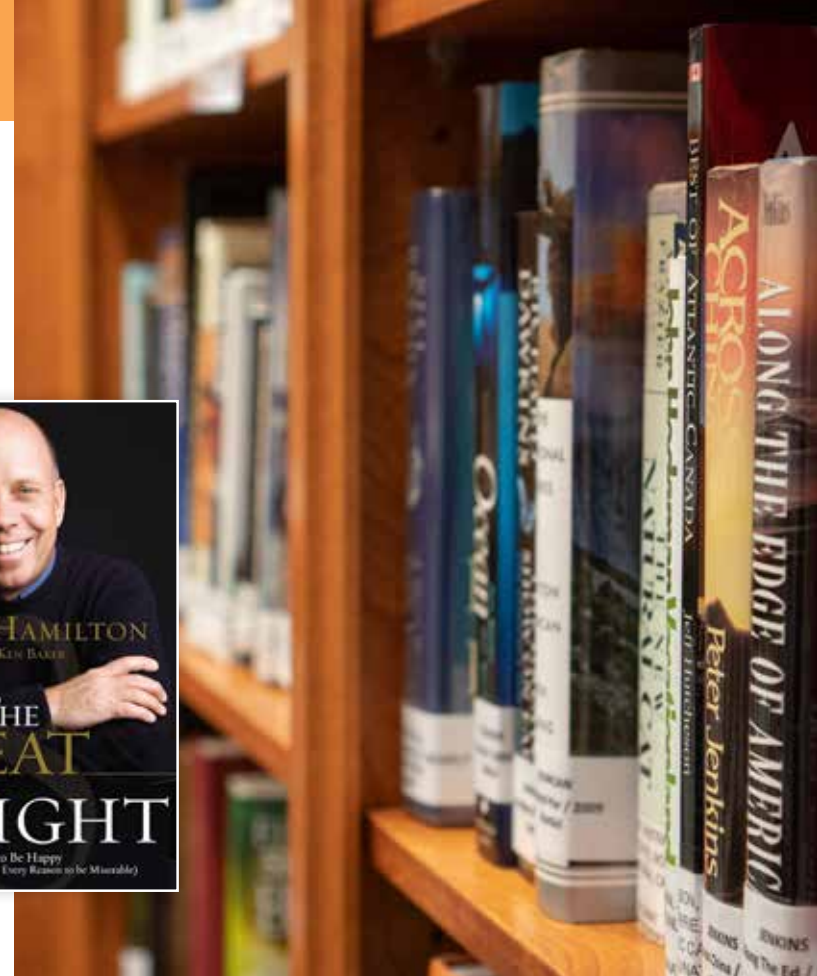
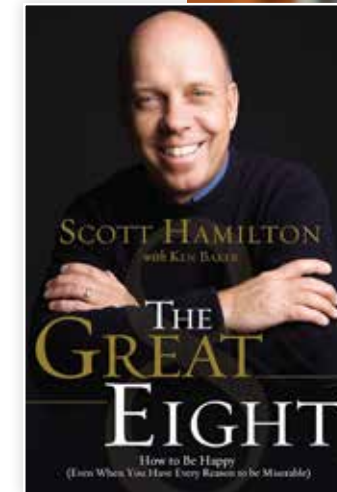
What's New on the Shelves?
