HOW OUR WISH LIST ITEMS HELP RESIDENTS

All the items on our wish list are important to supporting and improving the lives of residents in the care areas. Here are three examples from our current list.

Blanket Warmer

- Warm blankets are used by Nursing and Activities for many purposes:
- Soothe someone that is restless, has anxiety or has trouble sleeping.
- Ease pain.
- For some with dementia, it is the perfect sensory experience, like a warm hug.
- Warm a resident after their shower while they are drying off; many residents find it a challenge to stay warm, this can be a great solution.
- Staff can use this instead of or in coordination with medications for resident quality of life.

Broda Shower Chair

Broda shower chairs are designed with a higher back and can lean back. Regular shower chairs do not. This is ideal for a person that cannot sit in a regular chair due to positioning challenges or lack of control to sit in a chair. It is more comfortable and safer for those that need the extra support, and allows someone that would need to get a bed bath to get a shower instead.



Art with an Instructor

Our art instructor comes in monthly to paint with the residents, has experience with long term care residents, and is able to "break down" the project for all levels of care. He takes them step-by-step through the painting process, helping along the way and creates an atmosphere that makes all residents successful, ending with a beautiful painting.
