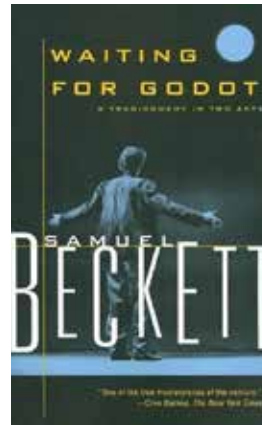
Fireside Theater – "Waiting for Godot"
