
The Herrnhut Community at Moravian Manor Communities

Offering Personal Care & Skilled Care Memory Support



Pelcome to the Herrnhut Community, located on Moravian Manor Communities' Founders Campus. This neighborhood is committed to caring for individuals with early-to-late stages of memory loss, dementia, and Alzheimer's disease, with the vision of helping these residents remain better-connected with the world around them.

Dedicated caregivers, trained in the provision of memory support, provide personal attention to each resident. These team members also receive continuing education to reinforce the best practices in care for residents with memory impairment.

Herrnhut Community includes an unsecured personal care neighborhood and separate secured skilled care neighborhood, both with services and support for those with varying degrees of memory impairment. The community is uniquely and intentionally designed to encourage independence and provide security for residents.

As a Life Plan Community, the programs, amenities, and services at Moravian Manor Communities reflect the needs of residents. From time to time, these components may change to better suit changing needs or as new service opportunities are identified.

Frequently Asked Questions

Are rooms private or shared?

Herrnhut community offers companion rooms and private rooms.

Does my loved one have to be a resident of Moravian Manor Communities to be admitted into the Herrnhut Community?

No, we can admit new residents directly into the Herrnhut Community. However, current residents have priority access to higher levels of care.

How does dining work? Will my loved one be able to order meals from a menu?

Yes, our country kitchens operate like a restaurant with staff that serves the meals. The seasonal menus change weekly with a variety of selections each day for breakfast that has both hot and cold selections, and lunch and dinner that feature two daily entrée choices and other regular selections.

Do you provide transportation?

Yes, we can provide transportation to medical appointments; there may be an additional charge for some transportation services.

Can residents continue to see their own doctor?

Yes, residents may continue to see their own physician other medical providers. They may also see our providers who visit on-site.

Do you have an orientation for new residents?

Yes. We realize that transitioning to a Memory Support Care residence can be stressful. Our staff will meet with your loved one to help him or her settle in and get to know our Life Plan community. They are also available on an ongoing basis to answer any questions.

Can residents bring their own furniture?

Yes, residents may bring personal furniture and furnishings all except for the bed, which should be reviewed with the memory support care home administrator prior to move in. If desired, residents may use the provided bedroom furnishings.

Does Medicare cover some of the cost for Memory Support Care?

No, Medicare does not cover Memory Support Care. Medicare does frequently cover Skilled Care or Rehabilitation Services after certain criteria have been met. For additional information specifically about Medicare, contact the Social Security Administration at 800-772-1213.

Frequently Asked Questions Continued

Do residents need long-term care insurance to move into the Herrnhut Community?

No, having long-term care insurance is not mandatory. However, it might help cover the costs of Assisted Living, Memory Care Support, Skilled Care or Home Health Care services. Check the terms of the resident's policy for any offered coverage.

Are pets permitted to visit?

Pets are welcome to visit areas of skilled care but may not reside in this area. We believe that pets help us live "in the moment" and have the innate ability to enrich our lives physically and emotionally. Visiting pets must follow our visitation guidelines. Please check with the Admissions representative for more information.

What is the admissions process for the Herrnhut Community?

- 1. Schedule an appointment with the Admissions Counselor.
- 2. Complete an application for review.
- Obtain financial and medical approval. We will provide you with a medical evaluation form for the personal physician to complete.
- 4. Meet with our Admissions team for a pre-admission assessment. The assessment is an opportunity for us to learn more about the prospective resident's preferences and discuss personal service needs.
