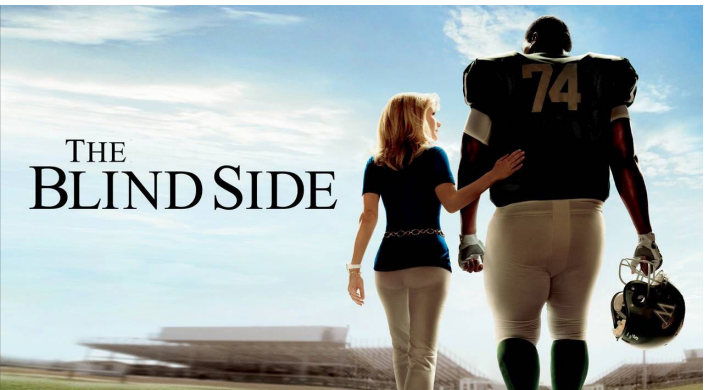

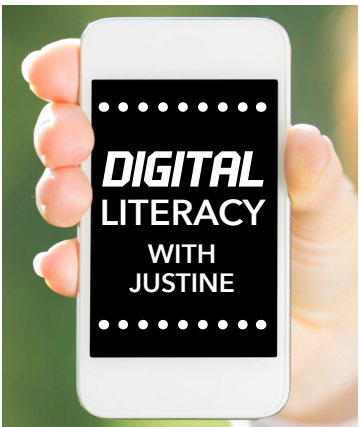

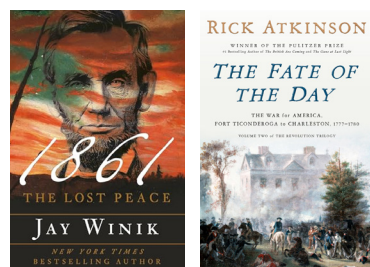
August is "Book Lovers Month!" Please stop by the Library at Founders Campus and check out the table for a list of favorite books by members of the Library Committee.
